It is available to buy from the school office for £10.



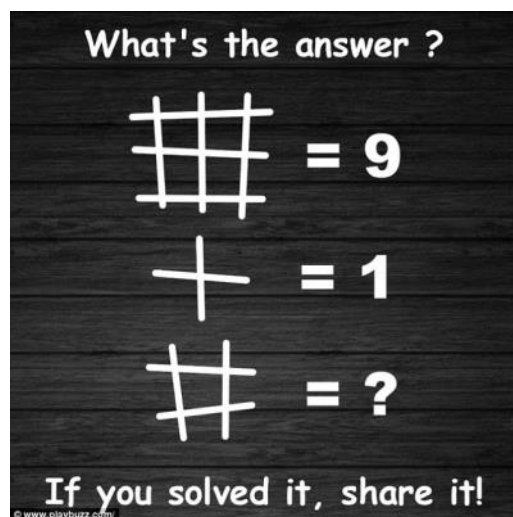
