School Council Meeting Meeting **Tuesday 20th November 2018 at 2:00 pm**

1. Welcome

Ms Mumby welcomed everyone to the meeting and said that we will make some important decisions today.

2. Anti-Bullying Code

The school council were asked to discuss anti-bullying code and judge posters.

Why do we need an anti-bullying code?

- To spread the message that we shouldn't bully
- Stop bullying
- To keep you safe
- Anyone can help you if you are being bullied because all adults and children will know what to do

A large piece of paper was given to groups in School Council to record ideas on different questions:

- What will Clapham Manor do to deal with bullying?
 - Phone the bullies parents
 - Talk to others teachers and collaborate to get the bully to talk to the teachers
- What to do if you see bullying or if you are a bystander?
 - Tell someone about it
 - Stand up for the person being bullied
- What is bullying?
 - When someone is mean to you repeatedly
 - When someone is mean to you online or through text messages
- What to do if you feel you are being bullied?
 - Don't be scared to tell an adult at home or at school if someone is hurting your feelings
 - Talk to friends that you trust about it or shared learning partners

- You could talk to the police, the NSPCC or ChildLine (there are posters around the school)
- What do we want from our Clapham Manor anti-bullying code?
 - We want it to stop bullying

Ms Mumby read out another schools anti-bullying policy

What should our anti-bullying code look like?

EYFS/KS1

- Pictures
- Diagrams
- Drawings
- Cartoons like on Twinkl website
- Easy to understand

KS2

Colourful

Positive steps to take

Statement of why we shouldn't bully

Different sections with small sentences - different sections could be in different colours

Write on it every day with a whiteboard so that people can share ideas or worries

School council looked at the anti-bullying posters and judged the top 3 posters.
