

## SUMMARY OF SUMMER 2018 PARENT SURVEY

We received 166 responses over 2 parent/carers conference evenings.

These figures are higher than the Autumn 2017 Parent/Carer Survey, indicating that parents/carers are currently very happy with the school.

2% of parents/carers responded negatively for the bullying statement and 6% did not respond. This is an improvement from Spring 2018.

There were many (31) positive comments across all year groups and a few (4) negative comments particularly referring to homework.

The main strengths highlighted by parents/carers via comments were:

- It is a great school
- Positive and encouraging environment where children are encouraged to do their best
- It is a happy, friendly and safe environment and the children are very happy
- There is great feedback from teachers, teachers are patient, committed, friendly and easy to talk to
- Appreciative of how hard everybody works
- Very happy with children's progress
- Happy with clubs but would like more
- School provides strong leadership skills for pupils and a receptive to parents' concerns

### Actions

- Review the homework policy with the SLT and bring to Pupil, Parent and Community Committee
- Anti-bullying with School Council
- More clubs
