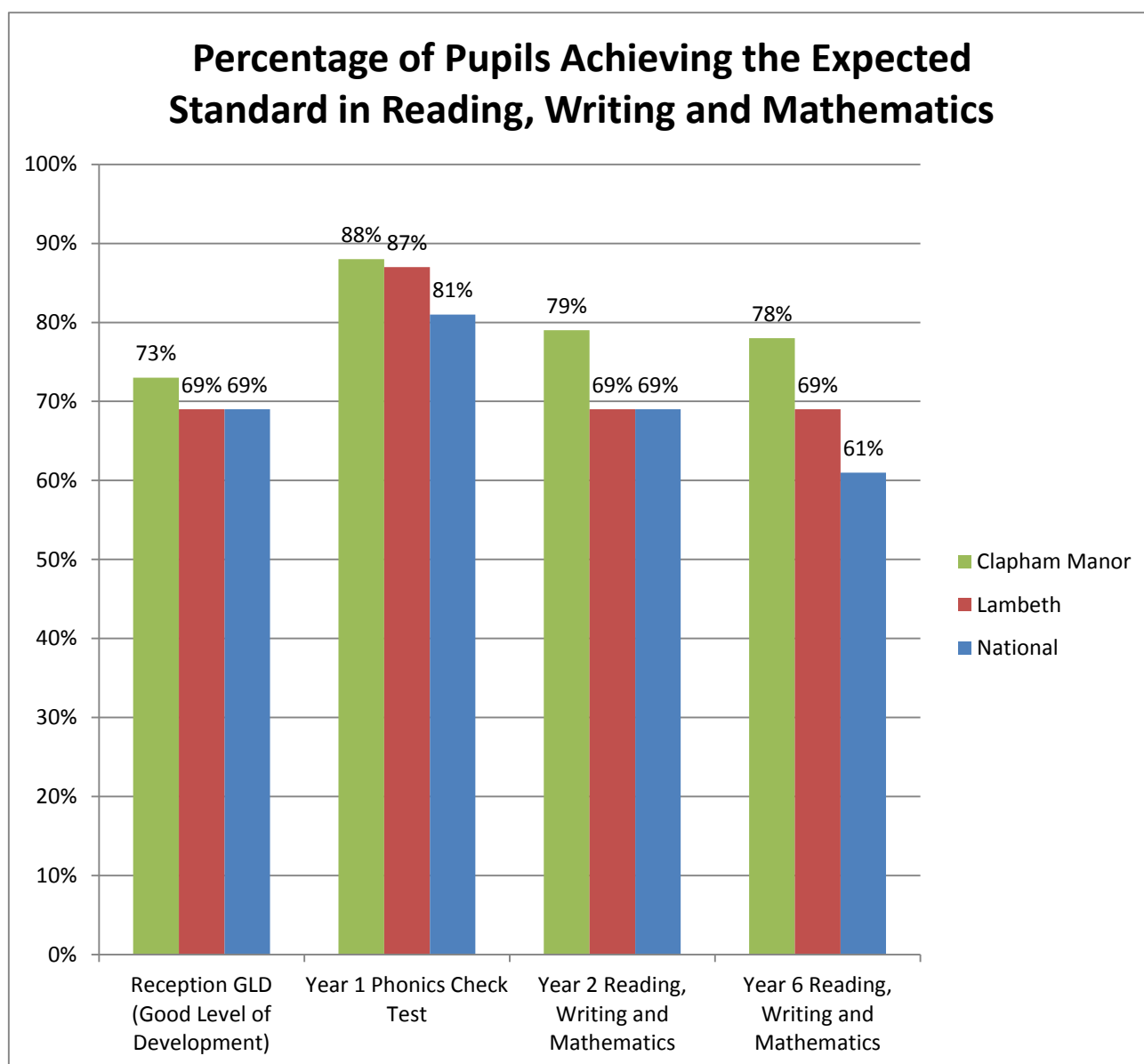
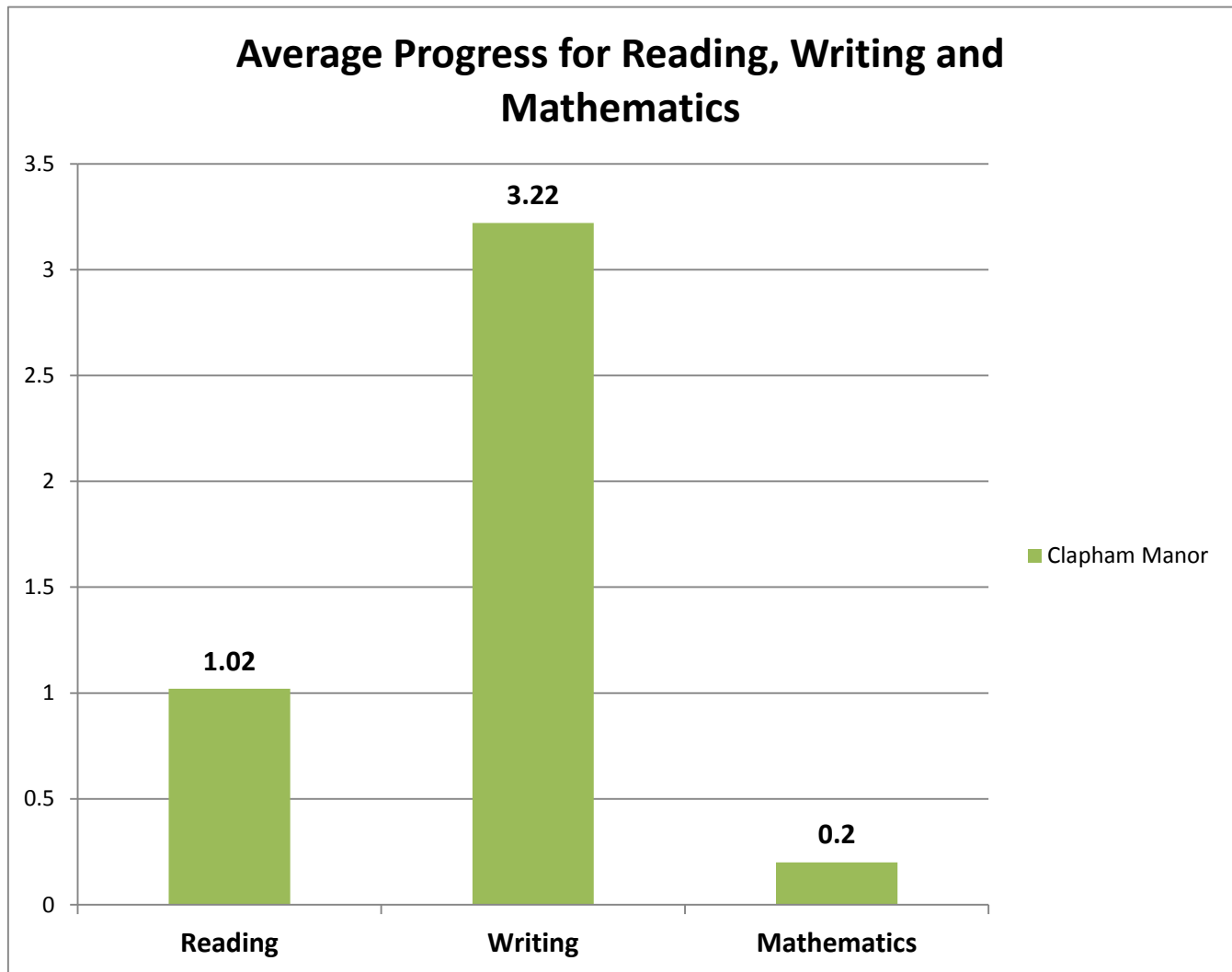

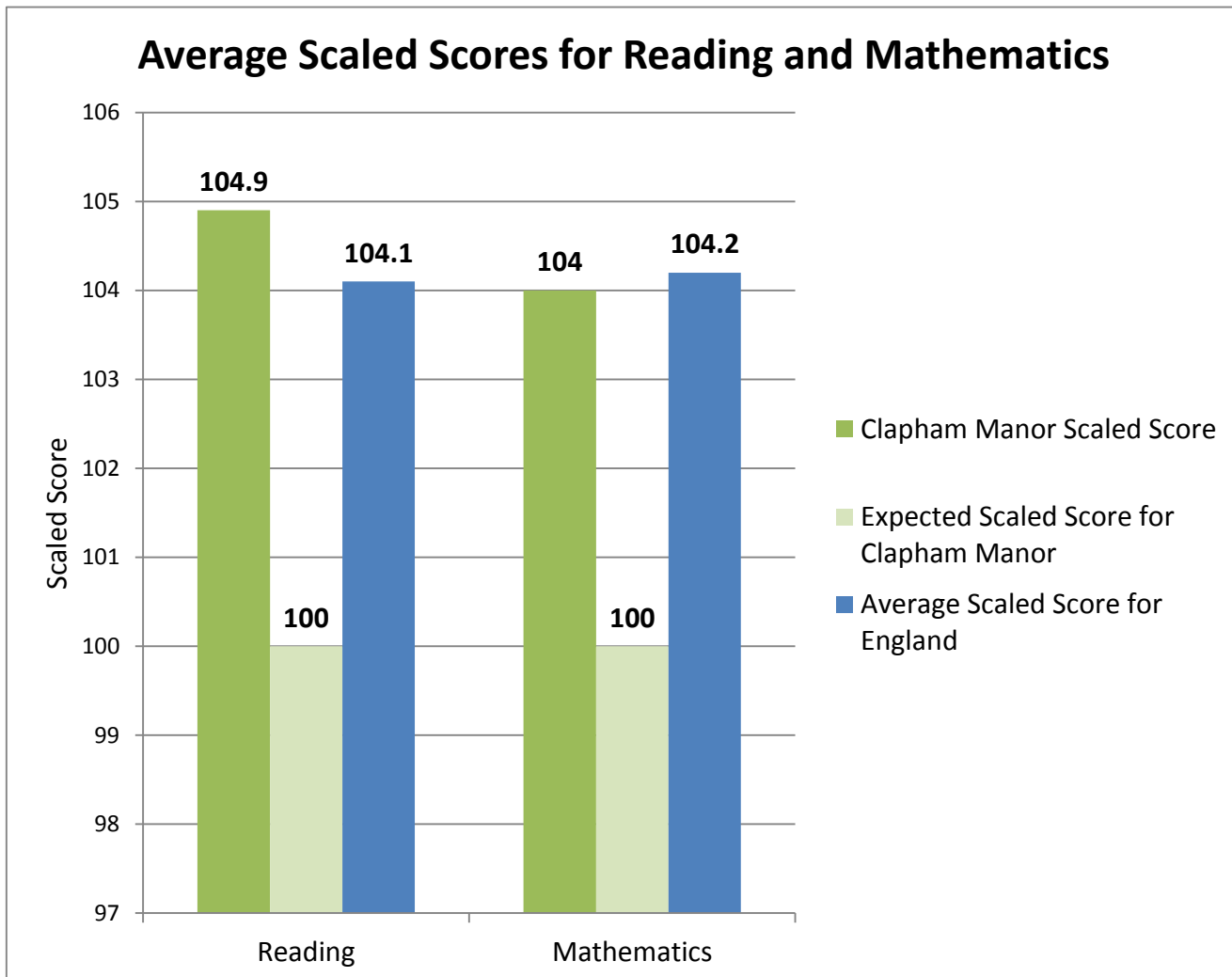

	A score of 110 to 120 means a pupil is achieving more than the expected standard.
