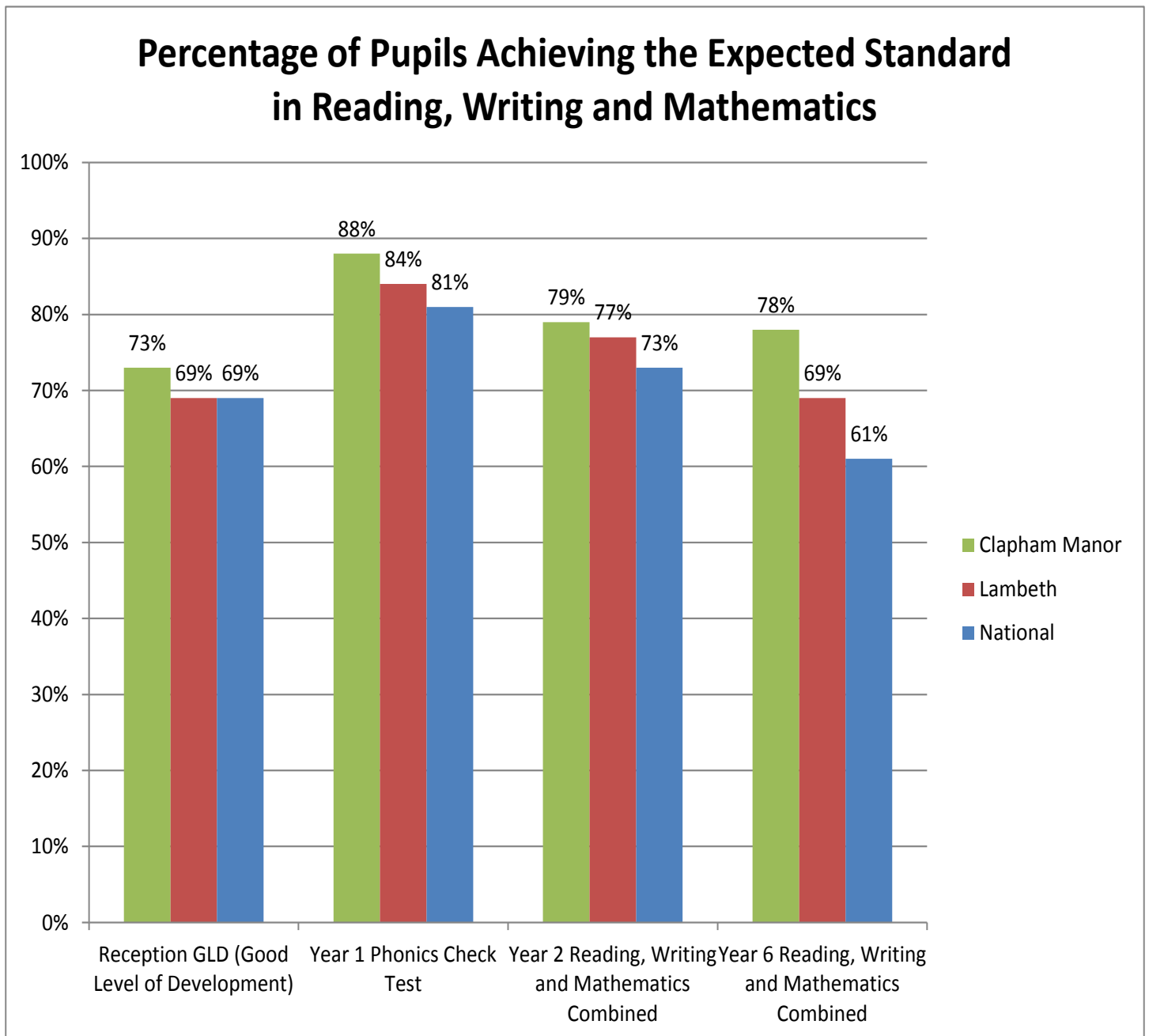
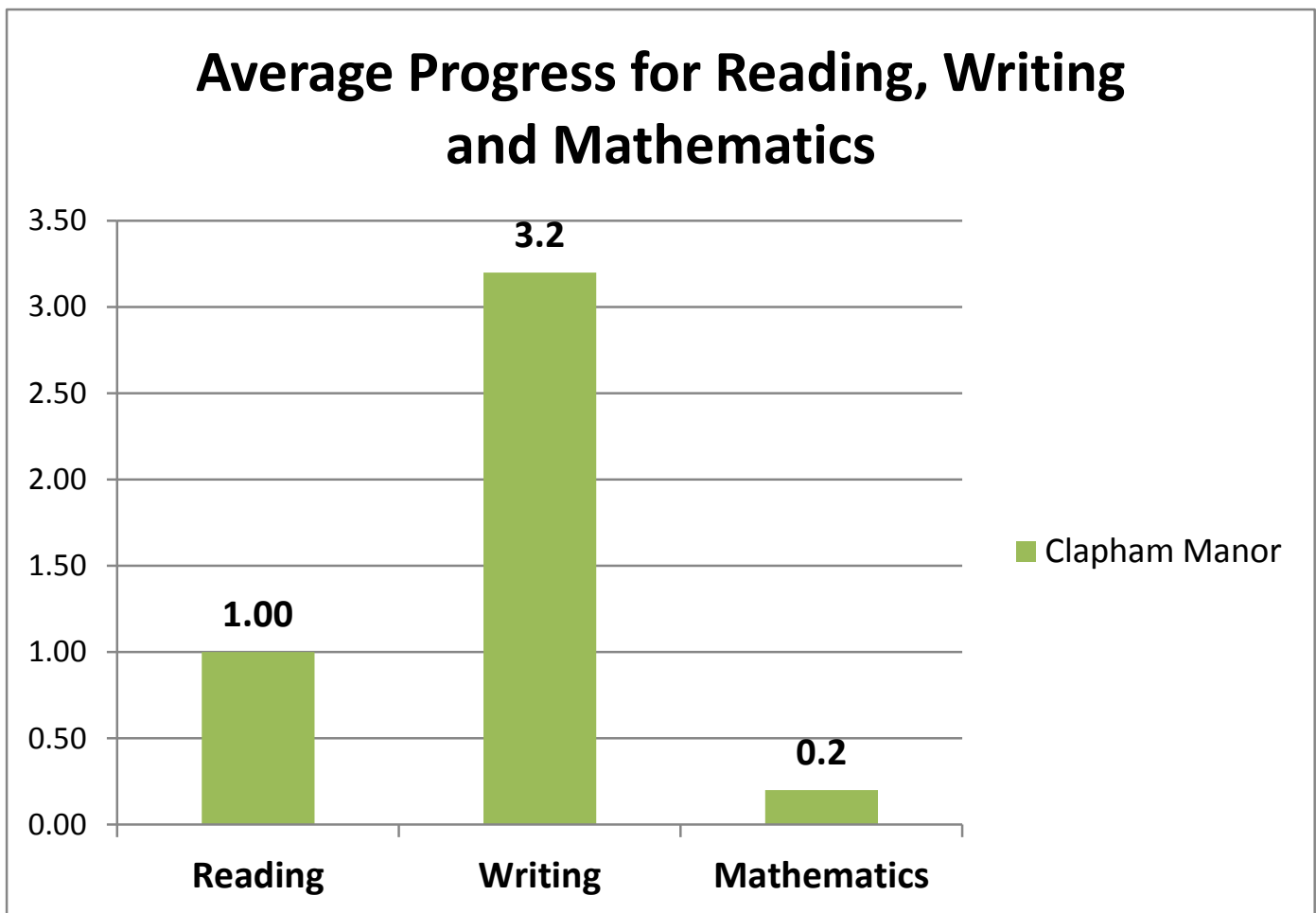

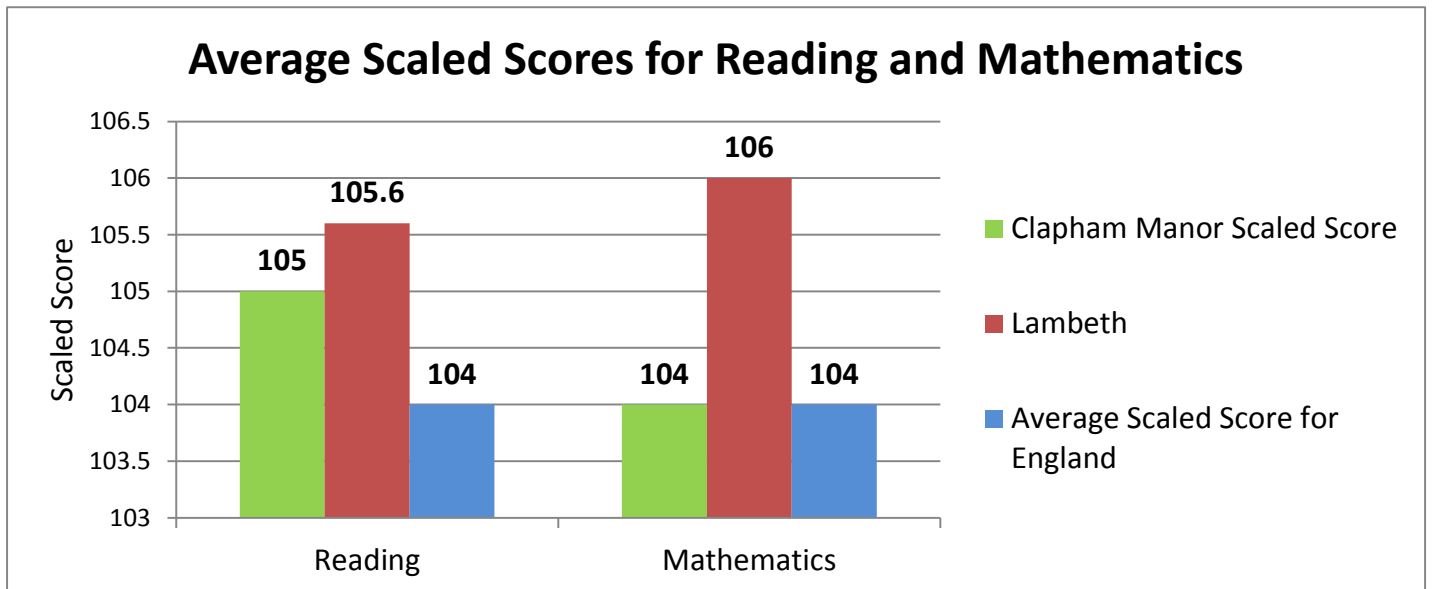
Percentage of Pupils achieving the expected standard in Reading, Writing, and Mathematics

Explanatory notes:	This score is a measure of progress for pupils from the end of Year 2 until the end of Year 6. A progress score of 0 means that on average pupils achieved similar results at the end of KS2 to pupils with similar results when they were in KS1. A positive result means that on average pupils made more progress.

Explanatory notes:	A Scaled Score is the way Government is assessing our Pupils. The scores go from zero to 120 and are the marks a pupil gets in the SATs tests.

	A score of 110 to 120 means a pupil is achieving more than the expected standard.
